Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was often noted as stagnant. Seller offerings were in a range of adequate to readily available and were in the closer balance on the under 3 pound sizes. Heavier weights, particularly 4 pound sizes were difficult to place. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were mostly heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 58 to 72 cents. Trade sentiment was barely steady to weak. In the parts complex, volumes and items available varied from plant to plant, but were fully sufficient to handle the generally light and spotty buying interest.


