 closing prices, slaughter steers and heifers  
 closed .50 to mostly 1.00 lower on early-  
 week losses. At midweek Western direct  
 cattle, beef demand, and futures all posted  
 stiff losses; but local slaughter cattle  
 showed their losses prior to the fundamen-  
 tal declines and late in week the market had  
 good strength. Holstein steers ended the  
 week mostly .50 lower. Slaughter cow  
 prices finished .50 lower, after holding  
 steady most of the week. Slaughter bulls  
 closed 1.00 lower with the best sales post-  
 ed late in the week on attractive supplies.  
 Supply was made up of around 37 percent  
 slaughter steers, 9 percent slaughter heif-  
 ers, 38 percent slaughter cows, 5 percent  
 bulls, with the balance feeders.

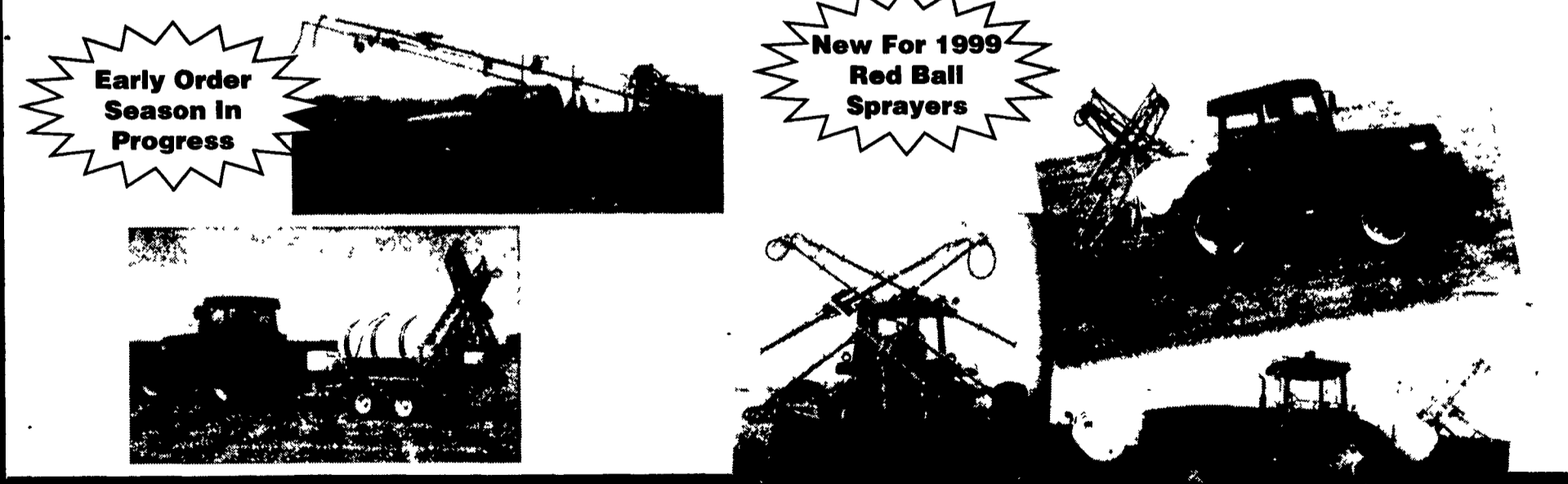
