for success. These farmers included Jeff Grove, Shippensburg, Benuel Z. Lapp, New Holland; and Daniel Mains,

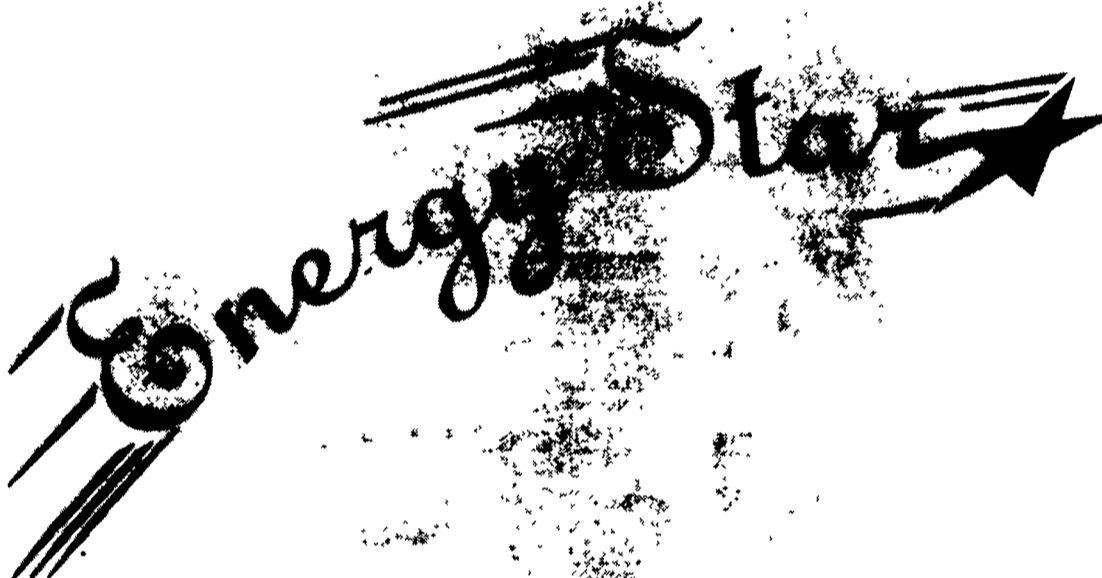
Newville.
