Quality was very good for this time of year and late sales were just as strong as the opening. Holstein steers sold steady to 1.00 higher and slaughter heifers were mostly steady in a light test. Slaughter cows sold firm to 1.00 higher, especially on the fleshier types, and slaughter bulls were steady. Supply included 39 percent slaughter steers and 37 percent slaughter cows.
