

# Pennsylvania 4-H Shooting Sports Committee To Conduct Instruction Certification Course

The Pennsylvania 4-H Shooting Sports Committee will conduct a training program and instructor certification course for adults interested in working with youths April 23-25 at Camp Mount Luther near Mifflinburg, Union County.

The workshop will be funded in part by grants from the "The NRA Foundation" the Federal Cartridge Company. Programming will involve specialized training and certification for instructors in the NRA / 4-H rifle, pistol, and shotgun shooting sports programs. Archery participants will receive National Archery Association Level 1 certification. Program participants will be certified to organize project clubs and conduct instruction in these program areas.

One hundred and twelve 4-H volunteer leaders from 37 counties participated in the Pennsylvania 4-H Shooting Sports workshop held in April 1997 in Butler county.

Several related projects and activities will also be introduced during this years training including "Woodworking for Wildlife", "Wildlife Through The Seasons", "Endangered Species" and the Penn State 4-H Habitat Evaluation contest.

The 4-H Shooting Sports program has grown rapidly in Penn-

sylvania with over 2,700 youths ages 8 to 18 completing projects in this program area in 1998.

4-H members receive training in marksmanship, firearm safety and handling. They also have the opportunity to compete in county, regional and statewide contests.

Air pistol, Air Rifle, Archery and .22 rifle contests are held for teens at 4-H State Achievement Days at Penn State University in July. The 1999 event will feature the first Pennsylvania 4-H shotgun contest.

The objectives of the program are:

1. Develop leadership abilities, build character and assume citizenship responsibilities.

2. Develop responsible sportsmanship, ethical behavior and respect for safe conduct of shooting sports activities.

3. Gain awareness and appreciation of the broad spectrum of shooting sports and related activities as life-long leisure opportunities.

4. Develop shooting knowledge and skills.

5. Become aware of related career opportunities.

6. Gain in-depth experiences in individual specialized areas of interest.

7. Gain enjoyable, positive relationships with adults and peers.

The Shooting Sports program has been well supported nationally by The National Rifle Association, shooting sports industries and volunteers.

Cost: \$75.00 per 4-H leader / Teen leader. This includes 2 nights lodging, 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 1 dinner and snacks, training materials.

Deadline is March 12, 1999. We can accept some after that date, but instructor packages have to be ordered at least 6 weeks in advance.

Instruction for the workshop was conducted by a certified team of Pennsylvania State University staff and 4-H volunteers.
