Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was slow to instances fair. Offerings were adequate to fully adequate and were generally more readily available on the heavier sizes. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were usually noted as desirable to heavy. Processing schedules were moderate to heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 56 to 70 cents. Trade sentiment was mostly steady. In the parts complex, supplies of bone-in breasts and wings were snug at most plants. Boneless skinless breasts were irregularly balanced. Drums were no more than adequate; however, other leg items were fully adequate.
