# Regional Director Says Extension Service Can Be Likened To Golden Gate Bridge

In fact, noted the Penn State Extension Service Capitol Region Director Dr. Michelle Rodgers, there's a metaphor she wanted everyone at the celebration to take home: The Golden Gate Bridge of San Francisco.

The bridge "is a fabulous structure with historical significance, with facilitative significance, managing and moving people," she said—an apt metaphor for the role of the Penn State Extension Service. The service is "part of the infrastructure here to improve lives, to make lives better," she said.

For the bridge, the work on it is never completed. "When the painting is finished, they have to start all over again," she said of the upkeep needed on the magnificent structure. The same is true of cooperative extension. "Our work to improve lives is never done, is a constant job," she noted.

Like the Golden Gate Bridge, extension is constantly updating itself. Rodgers indicated that in the coming months, significant changes have already been put in


