Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder steers firm to 2.00 higher; feeder heifers 1.00-3.00 higher. Demand good for feeder cattle. Steer and heifer calves steady with very good demand. Bulk supply 600-850 lbs feeder cattle. Weigh-ups gaunt to average, few full. Feeders in mostly medium flesh off wheat. Quality average to attractive, end plain. Improvement in the slaughter cattle market is allowing feeder cattle to retain price levels established in beginning of year. However, further improvement in feeders will require a large upward movement in spring slaughter prices as a great deal has already been built into this feeder price level. A clean up of heavy weights in the north this month along with minor relief from the Russian deal scheduled to begin in March could bring about the

slaughter market that is sought. Slaughter cows weak. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. Demand very good for replacement cows with most old cows bred to calve through May returning to country. Total of 400 cows and bulls with 45 percent to packers. Receipts this week 10,550; last week 4,979; last year 7,742. Supply consisted of 72 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 24 percent calves and short yearlings under 600 lbs; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
