Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary
Compared to last week: Feeder, stocker, and steer calves weak to 2.00 lower. Feeder heifers 1.00-2.00 lower. Stocker heifers and heifer calves firm. Demand moderate for feeders; good for stockers and calves. All Conditions well below last week. Quality plain to average, few attractive. Feeders in medium to moderate flesh, some fleshy and not all flesh due to wheat. Weigh-ups gaunt to mostly average, several full. Calves in thin to medium flesh. Cattle on feed report caused concern and had some effect early in the sale but kind and condition of cattle were larger factor in down-

trend. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Packer demand moderate at best. Bulk of receipts bred cows or thin cows returning to the farm. Total of 500 cows and bulls sold with 30 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 14,900; last week 12,125; last year 17,147. Supply consisted of 76 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 21 percent calves and short yearlings under 600 lbs; 3 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

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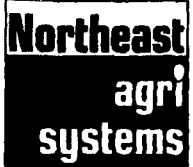
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
