

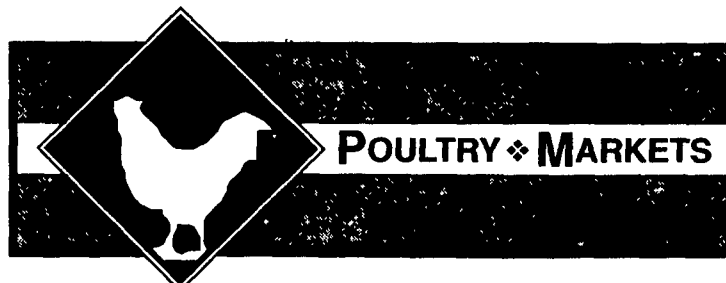

NATIONAL EGG MARKET - AT A GLANCE
In Philadelphia and the Southern area prices were unchanged to one cent higher, and in New York prices were one cent higher on all sizes. Elsewhere prices were unchanged. The market tone was steady to firm. Demand ranged light to good, mostly moderate, with retail features continuing to stimulate the best interest. In the Northeast, extra large eggs remained in the tightest position. Elsewhere, supplies were generally adequate to available. Breaking stock supplies were usually adequate for the light to fair demand. Light type fowl were adequate to ample for slaughter schedules.
