ture and the Department of Environmental Protection have to get their heads together and see if this plan really made the improvements that we thought it was going to.

"They can say, well we worked on nitrogen and nitrogen is nice because we can do a number of things with it to manage it. But with phosphorus, it doesn't come off as a gas, it doesn't move, it tends to stay put. We use a whole lot less phosphorous in farming than we do nitrogen."

Also included in the plan is what

to do with the excess manure whether to dry it and sell it or give it to a neighbor.

Some of the tougher questions asked is what's happening in the barnyards?

"That's actually where we find our biggest improvements," said Conrad. "You guys are in a situation right here that everywhere you look you're either downhill or uphill from somewhere."

Storm water runoff is also a major consideration. Conrad also overviewed the various cost share programs that are now available.

"There are many people certified to write a plan or you can write one yourself. Either way there are

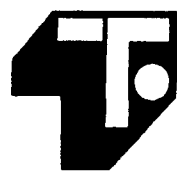

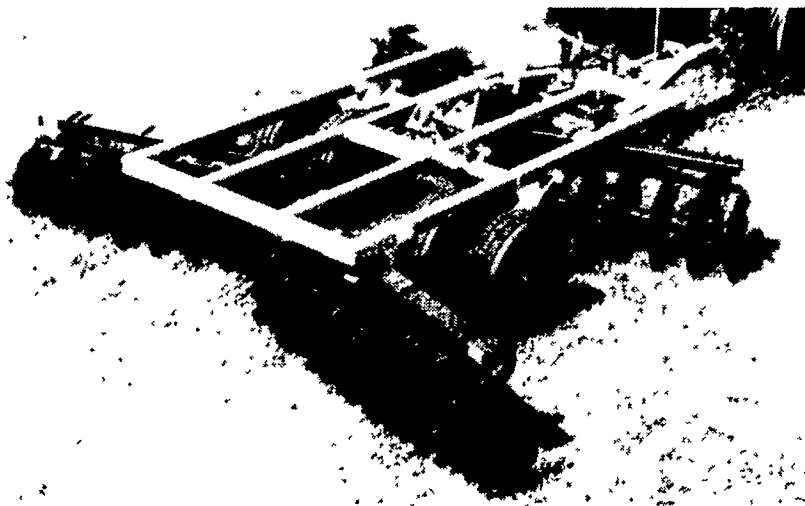
