Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Steers steady to 1.00 lower, full decline on 800 weights. Heifers 1.00-2.00 lower. Demand moderate for all classes. Light receipts due to soft field conditions after 2 inch rains over the weekend coupled with normal decline in numbers of cattle off wheat. Quality average. Weigh-ups average. Feeder cattle in medium to moderate flesh off wheat. Slaughter cows firm to 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00 higher. Packer demand very good. Cows and bulls totaled 240 head with 60 percent to packers. Receipts this week 5,600; last week 13,191; last year 8,921. Supply consisted of 73 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 23 percent calves and short yearlings under 600 lbs; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

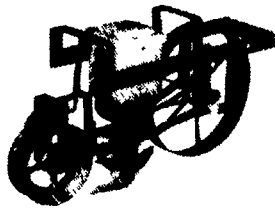

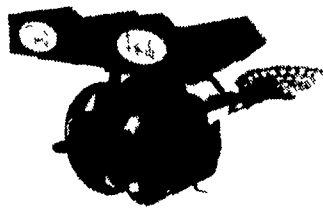

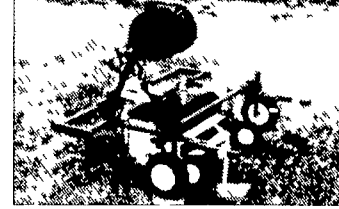
