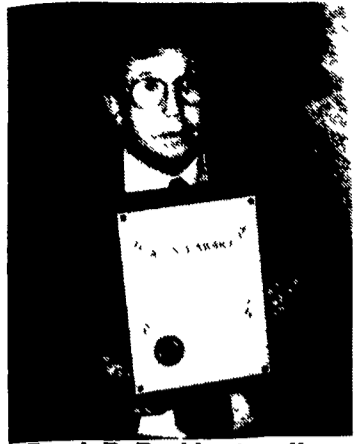

lution and the increasing stormwater flows in the area, LandStudies, Inc., in cooperation with the Lititz Run Watershed Alliance, designed a structure to manage 80 to 90 percent of the watershed by redirecting the flow through 2.8 acres of wetland."

After construction in September and October 1998, the wetland was installed on a community planting day by a large force of neighbors, students, and other volunteers with native plants supplied by Octoraro Native Plant Nursery.

Meck said, "This facility is truly a multiple-use facility, providing sediment and stormwater control while enriching our environment by providing an ideal observation site for visitors to observe the various wildlife that will congregate in this newly created habitat."
