TIP OF THE WEEK

Take indoor plants outside during a warm spring rain to shower off the winter's dust and restore the leaves.

VEGETARIAN STROGANOFF

- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 pounds mushrooms, sliced
- 1 tablespoon flour
- 1/2 cup white wine (optional)
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 12 ounces egg noodles

wine (if desired) and sour cream into any remaining broth in the pan. Cook for 1 to 2 minutes to thicken, add nutmeg, and return vegetables to pan to heat through. Serve over cooked noodles.

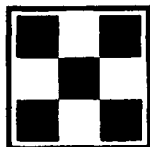

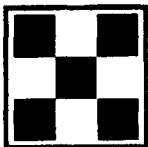
