Holstein steers were fully steady. A light run of slaughter cows sold weak and slaughter bulls were steady to 1.00 higher. Supply included 67 percent slaughter steers and 8 percent slaughter cows.

CATTLE Compared to Monday, a light offering of slaughter steers sold firm, instances .50 higher. Trading never leveled out due to the small supply, but the strength was evident on all sales. CATTLE: Compared to Tuesday, slaughter steers and heifers sold steady to firm. Fat cattle prices were 1.50 higher than last week and the supply was much improved. Holstein steer demand continues to be good and prices were steady to .50 higher. Slaughter cows sold weak to .50 lower in slow trading, while the slaughter bulls traded mostly steady. Supply included 41 percent slaughter steers and 30 percent slaughter cows.

CALVES: Compared to Monday's auction, veal calves sold 1.00 to 4.00 higher in a light test. Slaughter calves were 2.00-7.00 higher in fairly active trading. The Holstein bull calves returning to feed sold sharply higher than Monday's light test, with prices ranging 30.00-40.00 higher. Demand was good for Holstein heifers, but there was not a good price comparison for Monday. Supply included 345 head in the State graded sale and around 89 percent returned to the farm.


