Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder and stocker steers 2.00-3.00 higher. Feeder and stocker heifers 1.00-2.00 higher. Demand very good for steers. Demand good for heifers under 700 lbs; moderate for heifers over 700 lbs. Quality average, few attractive. Feeders in medium to moderate flesh, few fleshy. Weigh-ups average. Spring coming along nicely with adequate moisture providing good start to pastures. Grass people still remembering last years drought and have attentioned focused on making hay as supplies are depleted throughout the state. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. Total of 250 cows and bulls sold with 55 percent to packers. Receipts this week 7,400; last week 10,034; last year 8,502. Supply consisted of 73 percent yearlings over 600 lbs;

24 percent calves and short yearlings under 600 lbs; 3 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

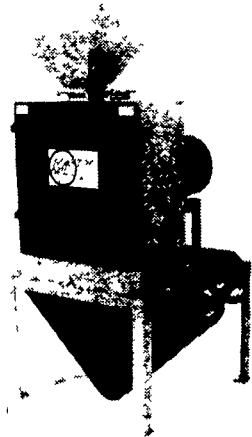

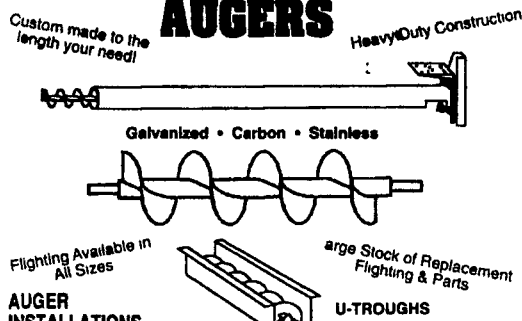
