Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 2.00 lower, full decline on steers over 850 lbs and heifers over 750 lbs. Demand moderate to good for large run of feeder cattle off wheat. May wheat run starting full week earlier than last year as mild winter causing some wheat to mature early. Feeder cattle in mostly moderate wheat flesh. Weigh condition average. Genetic quality mostly average, however all qualities of feeder cattle packing the flesh. Stocker cattle steady with good demand. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady to 1.00 lower. Packer demand moderate to good. Demand very good for thin cows. Bulk supply of cows in average to gaunt conditions. Total of 450 cows and bulls sold with 40 percent to packers.

Receipts this week 15,600; last week 7,402; last year 7,919. Supply consisted of 81 percent yearlings over 600 lbs, 16 percent calves and short yearlings under 600 lbs; 3 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
