Why be confined to a certain amount of stalls? Learn how to make a low-cost parlor that will work for a pipeline or with bucket milkers.

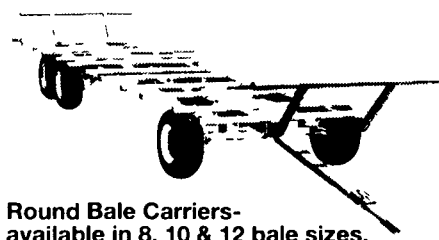
Expand your herd as you get more grass. We will also hear how to winter cows out on pasture, plus more interesting ideas.

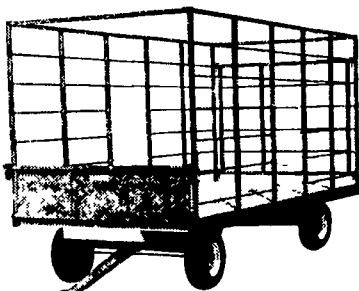


Round Bale Carriers—available in 8, 10 & 12 bale sizes.

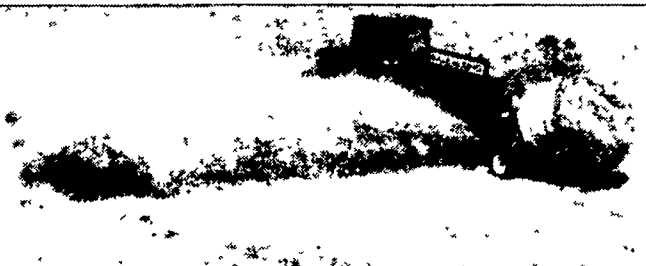
