A WEAK FUTURES MARKET HAS PRESSURED PRICES OVER THE LAST TWO WEEKS, BUT BOXED BEEF PRICES HAVE BEEN ABLE TO HOLD THEIR GROUND. THE WESTERN DIRECT CATTLE MARKET REMAINED STEADY THIS WEEK, TRADING AT 65.00-65.50 LIVE TO 103.00-104.00 DRESSED. 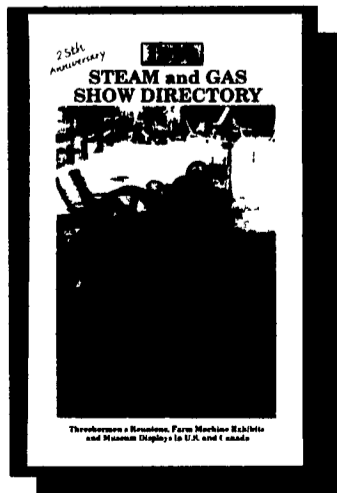
