CATTLE: Compared to last week's closing prices; slaughter steer trading turned very active at midweek and closed 1.50 to mostly 2.00 higher, after opening on the weak side Monday. The market finally flexed enough muscle to break out of the narrow trading range that has caged prices for months. Buyers were aggressive for all classes of slaughter steers, after boxed beef cut-out values broke 110.00 for both light and heavy Choice carcasses. Midwest fat cattle sold 1.00 higher this week at 66.00 live and 104.00 in the beef. Local Holstein steers sold 1.00-1.50 higher with good demand. There were not enough slaughter heifers on offer late in the week to fully test the market. Slaughter cow prices closed .50-1.00 higher this week on a light, but attractive offering. Slaughter bulls ended firm to 1.00 higher. Supply included 54 percent slaughter steers, 6 percent slaughter heifers, 27 percent slaughter cows, 6 percent slaughter bulls, with the balance made up of feeder cattle.

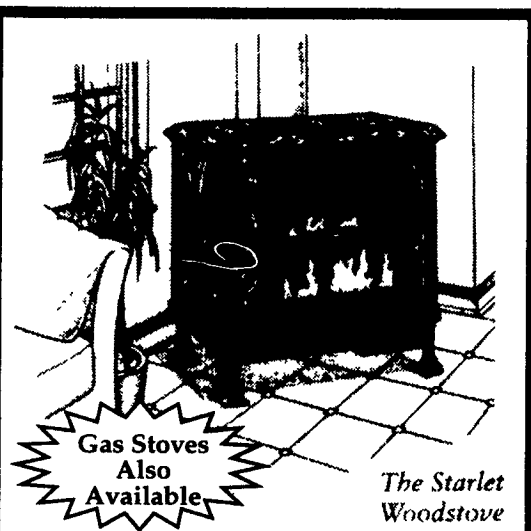
