## Chicken Pot Pie

### Dough:

- 2 cups flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 eggs
- 2-3 tablespoons water

To make pot pie dough, make a well in the flour and add the eggs and salt. Work together into a stiff dough. If it is too dry, add water or milk. Roll out the dough as thin as possible ¼ -inch thick and cut into 1-inch squares with a knife or pastry wheel. Drop into boiling broth.

## Pot Pie

- 4-pound chicken
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 4 medium potatoes, sliced
- 2 tablespoons minced parsley

Cut chicken into serving pieces, cover and cook until tender. Season with salt. When chicken is almost soft, add squares of pot pie dough. Cook 20 minutes longer. Add chopped parsley. Serves 6-8.

## B-B-Q For 100 Chicken Halves

- 1 gallon white vinegar
- 3 pounds butter
- ½ pound salt
- 1 gallon water

Heat well. Do not boil. Put in clean or new sprayer bottle and spray on chicken. Place on grill.

## Soda Crackers

- 3 cups pastry flour
- 1 cup rye flour
- ¾ cup butter
- ½ cup brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- Salt to taste

Mix ingredients together like pie dough. Add one beaten egg and enough milk (approximately ½ cup) to wet dough to roll. Roll thin and sprinkle with salt.

## Soda Crackers

- 7 cups flour
- 1 heaping teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1¼ cups lard
- 1 tablespoon salt
- 1½ cups cream or milk

Mix like pie dough, roll out, cut in squares and bake on cookie sheets.

## Wheat Crackers

- 4 cups wheat flour
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- 4 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 cup butter
- 1½ cups water
- 1 teaspoon salt

Mix flour, baking powder, sugar, and salt. Add butter and mix well, then add water and mix until batter is smooth. Roll thin. Cut in squares or rectangles and bake at 350 degrees until browned.

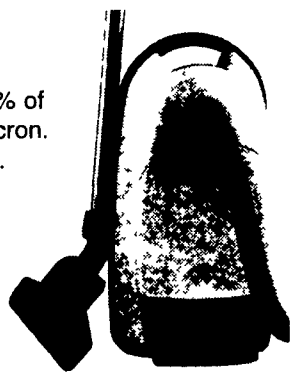

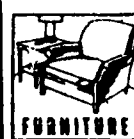
