5 tablespoons butter, divided 1½ cups whole tiny onions, peeled\*

1 teaspoon sugar

¼ teaspoon ground thyme

4 cups beef stock or consomme Salt and pepper

4 slices crustless bread, cubed

% cup chopped parsley 1/4 cup provolone cheese, shred-

ded (optional)

Melt 3 tablespoons butter in large saucepan. Add onions and stir to coat in the butter. Sprinkle onions with sugar, stirring constantly over medium heat, cook until light and brown. Add thyme, beef stock, and salt and pepper to taste; cover and bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer for 20 minutes.

Melt remaining 2 tablespoons butter in large frying pan. Stir in bread cubes and fry until cubes are light brown.

To serve, divide bread cubes and parsley into four bowls. Divide soup into bowls. Top with provolone cheese if desired. Serve with crusty French bread. Yields 4


