

Arabian Horse Farms Open To Tour

- On Sunday, May 23, the South East District of Pennsylvania Arabian Horse Association (PAHA) will sponsor a day of fun and learning for all horse lovers.

Five Arabian hoarse farms will be open to the public from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Admission is free. Visitors drive their own vehicles from farm to farm at their own pace, visiting as many farms as they choose, and spending as much time as

they like at each farm.

The primary purpose of the day is to introduce people to the Arabian horse. The day promises to be fun and educational for all. there will be items of interest for both the person contemplating buying their first horse and for the current Arabian enthusiast.

PAHA members support the farms by providing exhibitions of Arabians in may different disciplines. The exhibitions include Hunter, English, Western

Pleasure, Native Costume and Dressage. Horses will be shown at Liberty and in-hand.

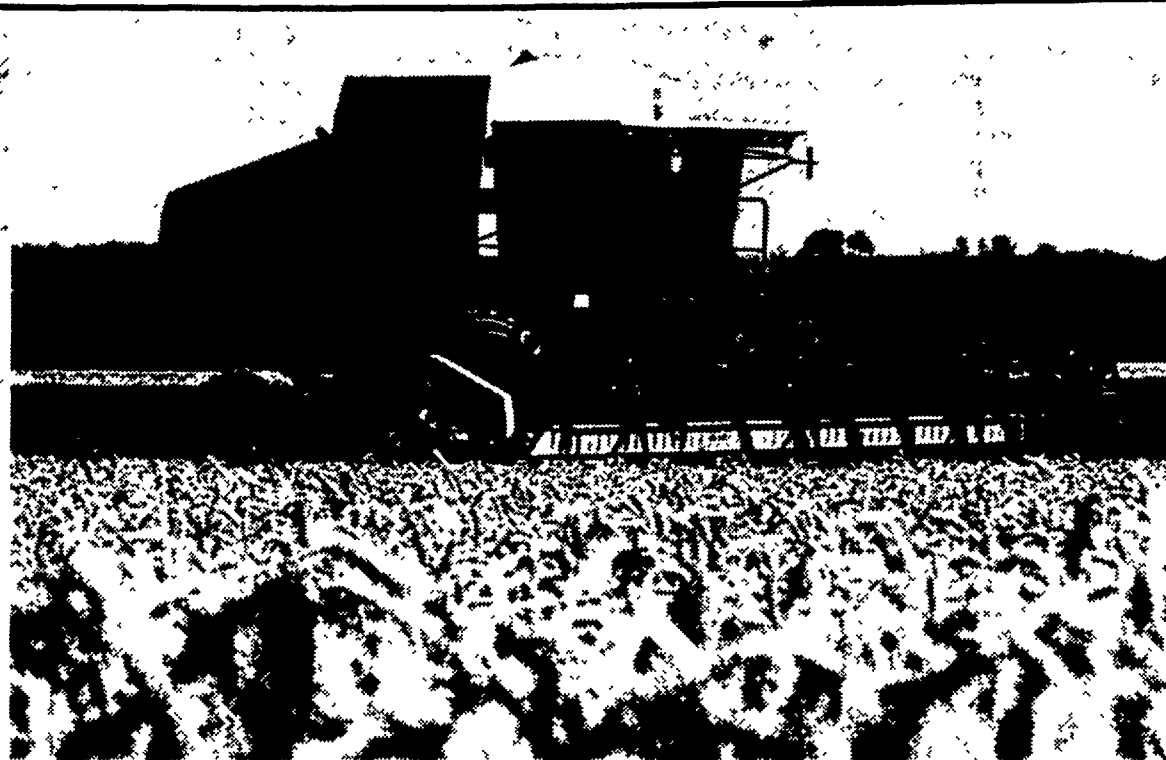
