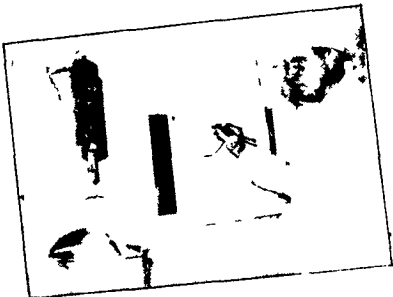
The best way to review agriculture over the last 100 years
