Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was slow, and was generally noted as insufficient to satisfactorily clear seller offerings. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights varied in a full range of light to heavy. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were 1 cent lower at 55 to 69 cents. Trade sentiment was mostly weak. In the parts complex, inquiry had increased on

selected items, however, all items remained at least adequate for immediate needs. Leg cuts were generally noted as in best balance. Breast items were fully adequate to ample. Wings were ample.
