Whole egg and whites were unchanged to higher, sugared yolks unchanged and salt yolks unchanged to lower. Undertone was unsettled on yolks, and fully steady on whole and whites. Demand was fair. Supplies were occasionally short to adequate. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending May 15, 1999 were unchanged from last week, and 6% less than the same week a year ago. Shell egg supplies were adequate.
