CATTLE Compared to Thursday, slaughter steer and heifer 50-75 higher. Cows steady to 200 higher, with several young cows selling 1000-1200 higher, couple 2000 higher than slaughter price, sold for dairy replacements. Bulls steady, with a few sales 200-300 higher. Supply included 49 percent slaughter steers and 36 percent slaughter cows. Bulls sold mainly on Monday and cows on Tuesday.

SLAUGHTER STEERS: High Choice and Prime 2-4 1220-1425 lbs 65.50-67.00, couple 67.25-67.50, with a couple lots 1450-1475 lbs 64.85-65.50. Choice 2 1150-1450 lbs 66.00-67.75, few 68.50-69.00. Choice 2-3 1150-1450 lbs 63.75-66.25, couple lots 66.50, couple head 1510-1515 lbs 62.25-62.75. Select and low Choice 2-3 1100-1500 lbs 61.00-64.00.

Supply included 406 head in state graded sale and around 95 percent of supply returned to feed.

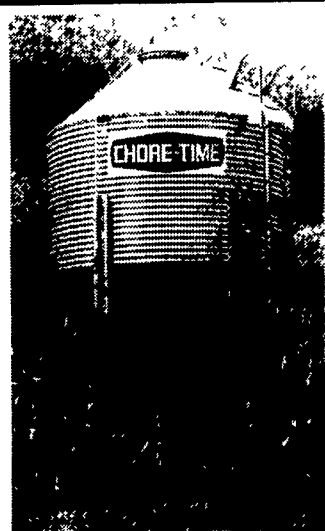

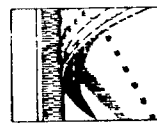
