This show is open to all members of 4-H or FFA without regard to state of residence and will be conducted according to the following rules:

1. All exhibitors belong to 4-H or FFA.

2. No limit on number of entries per exhibitor.

3. 65-pound minimum weight with 5 pound tolerance; no maximum.

4. All entries must be sired by registered Hampshire Shropshire rams. Registry number must be provided on entry.

5. All entries must be out of registered Hampshire Shropshire ewes. Registry number must be provided on entry.

6. All lambs must have approved Maryland or interstate health papers.

7. Wether and ewe lambs will be shown in four classes divided by weight. No rams will be shown

8. Lambs must carry all lamb's teeth.

9. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor.

10. Exhibitors will required to remove bedding and manure from the fair grounds.

11. Entry fee (must accompany entry), \$10 per head for members of Maryland Hampshire Sheep Association, \$20 per head for non-members.

12. Weigh-in time: 2 p.m.

13. Show time: 3 p.m.

immediately 14. Release: after selection of champion.

15. Prizes: grand champion: \$100; reserve champion: \$50; and trophies for first place in each weight division.

Entry in this event will qualify Hampshire exhibitors for showing up to five lambs in the

Hampshire Market Lamb Classes at the Maryland State Fair without paying the \$10 per head entry fee.


