Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers weak to mostly 2.00 lower. Demand moderate for feeders. Cattle futures sharply lower Monday in reaction to last Friday's bearish hog inventory report. Steer and heifer calves steady with good demand. Quality of feeder cattle supply average to mostly plain. Weigh-ups full to mostly average. Feeder cattle in

medium to moderate flesh, end fleshy. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Demand from packers and replacement buyers good. Total of 485 cows and bulls sold with 70 percent going to packers. Precipitation in Oklahoma has continued on the heavy side through June with much of the state accumulating 6-10 or more inches. Most pastures are as good as they can be with abundant hay made. *** The Oklahoma National Stockyards and the Oklahoma City Market News Office will be closed Monday July 5, 1999 in observance of the Fourth of July Holiday. There will be a one day sale on Tuesday July 6, 1999 which will include feeder cattle and calves followed by the slaughter cow and bull sale. *** Receipts this week 9,000; last week 12,356; last year 11,093. Supply consisted of 74 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 21 percent calves under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
