I must also thank all of the

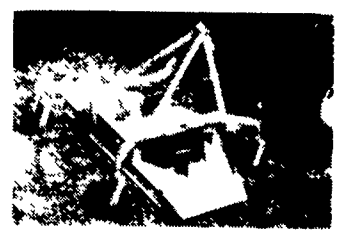
