IN BOSTON, PRICES WERE UNCHANGED TO 1 CENT HIGHER FOR THE LARGE SIZES AND MEDIUMS WERE UNCHANGED. IN NEW ENGLAND, PRICES WERE 2 CENTS HIGHER FOR JUMBOS, 4 CENTS HIGHER FOR EXTRA LARGE AND LARGE, 1 CENT HIGHER FOR MEDIUMS, AND UNCHANGED FOR

SMALLS. THE MARKET TONE WAS FULLY STEADY TO FIRM. DEMAND WAS FAIR TO GOOD, BEST WHERE ITEMS WERE FEATURED AND IN VACATION AREAS. SUPPLIES WERE TIGHT FOR JUMBOS AND EXTRA LARGE, ABOUT ADEQUATE FOR LARGE, AND ADEQUATE TO INSTANCES FULLY ADEQUATE FOR SMALLER SIZES. BREAKING STOCK OFFERINGS FROM REGULAR SOURCES WERE FULLY ADEQUATE TO AMPLE FOR THE VERY LIGHT DEMAND. LIGHT TYPE HENS WERE AMPLE FOR CURRENT TRADING NEEDS. 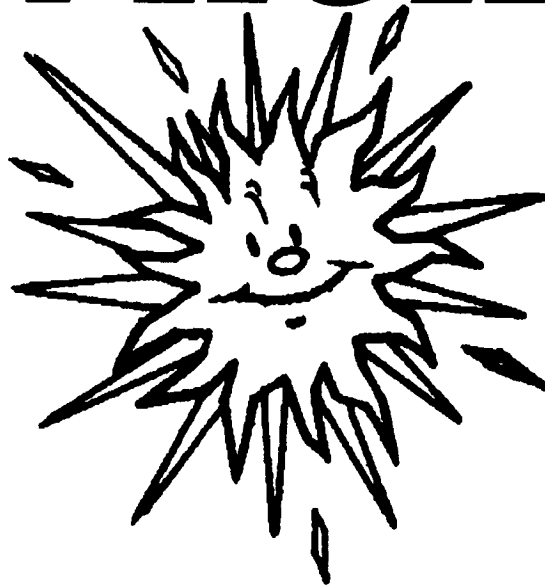
