Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to two weeks ago: Feeder steers 1.00 higher, feeder heifers 2.00-3.00 higher. Stockers 3.00-4.00 higher, few calves steady. Demand very good. Buyers aggressive with cheap feeds the driving force. Quality of supply plain to average, few attractive. Weigh-ups average. Feeder flesh condition medium; calf flesh medium to moderately fleshy. Slaughter cows 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls .50 lower. Demand very good for cows, bulls, and replacement cows and pairs. Consignment of high quality Brangus pairs and bred cows sold, however bulk of replacements lower quality cows. Total of 500 cows and bulls sold with 40 percent to packers. Receipts this week 9,400; last week 1,005; last year 16,240. Supply consisted of 74 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 21 percent calves; 5 percent cows and bulls. 43 percent of feeder supply was heifers. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

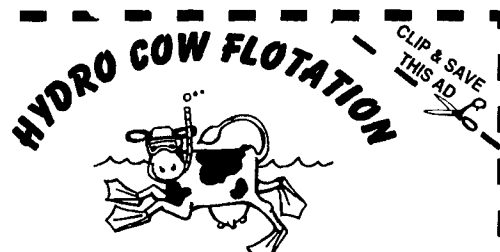
