CATTLE: Compared to Thursday, a thin test of slaughter steers and heifers sold steady. An attractive run of Holstein steers traded steady to firm. The offering was light, but all classes of slaughter cattle were represented. Slaughter cows were not fully tested. A light run of aged bulls sold steady to weak, but younger bullocks and stags sold firm. Supply included 39 percent slaughter steers and 5 percent slaughter cows.

SLAUGHTER STEERS: High Choice and Prime 2-4 1125-1285 lbs 64.75-67.00. Choice 2-3 1200-1310 lbs 63.50-65.00. Select and low Choice 2-3 1135-1395 lbs 58.50-62.75. Select 1-3 1150-1405 lbs 57.25-60.75, load blacks returning to feed 1090-1160 lbs 61.00-62.50.

HOLSTEIN STEERS: High Choice and Prime 2-3 1420-1520 lbs 56.75-58.50. Choice 2-3 1415-1650 lbs 55.35-56.50, couple 1667 lbs 53.75. Select and low Choice 2-3 1370-1545 lbs 52.25-55.25.

SLAUGHTER HEIFERS: Choice, few Prime 2-4 1110-1300 lbs 61.10-63.00. Select and low Choice 2-3 1055-1275 lbs 57.25-61.00.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Few Breakers 75-80 pct lean 42.75-46.75. Boners 80-85 pct lean 39.75-42.50. Few Lean 88-90 pct lean 35.00-37.75. Lightweight Lean 85-90 pct lean 32.25-34.50, low dressing 30.75-32.75.

CATTLE: Compared to Thursday, slaughter steers and heifers sold 50 to 100 higher. Trading was active and demand was on the increase for the first time in several weeks. Holstein steers sold steady to .50 higher. The slaughter cows sold mostly steady with Thursday's active market and slaughter bulls traded 1.00 lower. Supply included 49 pct slaughter steers and 42 pct cows.

SLAUGHTER STEERS: High Choice and Prime 2-4 1150-1485 lbs 65.50-68.75, few up to 70.25. Choice 2-3 1165-1465 lbs 63.25-66.25, high dressing 1-2 up to 68.50. Select and low Choice 2-3 1120-1530 lbs 60.00-63.50. Select 4-3 1090-1470 lbs 56.25-61.25, few returning to feed 1040-1220 lbs 59.75-61.75.

HOLSTEIN STEERS: Choice, few Prime 2-3 1350-1540 lbs 55.50-57.50. Select 1-2 1200-1385 lbs 49.00-52.25.

CALVES: Compared to last week, there was an unusually large number of calves on hand. Vealers traded as much as 10.00 higher, but orders were mostly filled by the time the graded calves sold. Holstein bulls sold firm to 15.00 higher with several local farmer feeders in the market. Trading was active, but buyers were very particular as to weight. Holstein heifers sold mostly 20.00 lower. Supply included 759 head in the State graded sale and 80 percent returned to feed.

VEALERS: Good and Choice 70-110 lbs 20.00-37.00. Standard and low Good 60-90 lbs 10.00-27.00.

RETURNED TO FARM: Holstein bulls 100-125 lbs 127.00-133.00, 90-100 lbs 80.00-102.00. Plainer-type bulls 90-115 lbs 40.00-85.00, weaker calves down to 30.00. Holstein heifers 85-115 lbs 220.00-257.00. Plainer heifers 85-110 lbs 197.00-230.00, 65-85 lbs 60.00-127.00. Beef-type bulls and heifers 80-110 lbs 60.00-105.00.

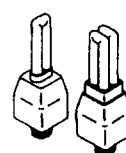
