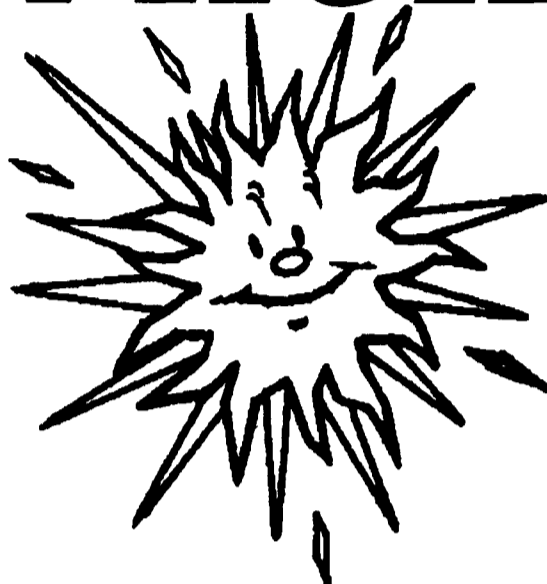
than last week, and 17% more than the same week a year ago.
