DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN SUMMARY

Grain and soybean bids took a breather from their recent sharp declines. Wheat steady to 5 cent higher. Corn 2 to 4 cents higher. Sorghum 8 cents higher. Soybeans mixed. The trade thought that recent sharp declines had been overdone and a little correction was necessary. New lows have been established on the Boards for the past several days. Very mild and dry July weather for the past few days has enveloped for a large part of the country. This has been very beneficial for wheat harvest and the pollination of early corn. However, the heat and more dry weather in the forecast but this is summer time. The shock of Monday's stock, use, and crop production reports wearing thin. Wheat harvest is moving up into the tier of states, as far North as South Dakota. Continued good

yields and protein counts are reported. Corn exports were huge last week and getting substantial tonnage announcements today.

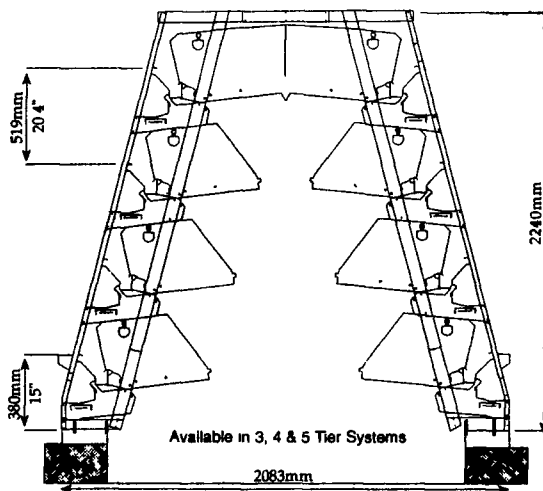

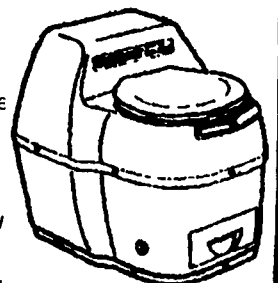
