A light run of slaughter cows sold mostly steady. Slaughter bulls sold mostly steady in active trading. Supply included 49 percent slaughter steers and 2 percent slaughter cows.

CATTLE Compared to Thursday, slaughter steers and heifers sold 50 to 100 higher. Trading was active and demand was on the increase for the first time in several weeks. Holstein steers sold steady to 50 higher. The slaughter cows sold mostly steady with Thursday's active market and slaughter bulls traded 1.00 lower. Supply included 49 pct slaughter steers and 42 pct cows.

Holstein bulls sold firm to 15.00 higher with several local farmer feeders in the market. Trading was active, but buyers were very particular as to weight. Holstein heifers sold mostly 20.00 lower. Supply included 759 head in the State graded sale and 80 percent returned to feed.

CATTLE: Compared to Tuesday, slaughter steers and heifers sold .50 lower. A fair number of late cattle traded as much as 1.00 lower, after buyers had mostly filled their orders. A good run of Holstein steers sold .50-1.00 lower. Slaughter cows sold 3.00, instances 4.00 lower to end the week as much as 6.00 lower. Slaughter bulls traded 1.00 lower, but top quality bulls were not well tested. Supply included 48 pct slaughter steers and 31 pct cows.


