Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder cattle and calves steady with good demand. Quality very typical for summer and average to mostly plain, end attractive. Feeder cattle in medium to moderate flesh, end fleshy. Several strings of calves in supply and these in moderate to fleshy conditions. Weigh-ups average to full. Slaughter cows and bulls 3.00-4.00 lower. Packer demand moderate. Total of 320 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 9,375; last week 9,430; last year 10,430. Supply consisted of 75 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 22 percent calves; 3 percent cows and bulls. Heifers comprised 37 percent of the supply. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
