DFA To Delay Vote

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Dairy Farmers of America (DFA) announced this week that it will wait until the August 6 deadline set by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) to cast its vote on federal market order reform.

"The Board decided to wait to cast our ballot in hopes that we can pass legislation to implement a more favorable pricing system," said DFA President and Chief Executive Officer Gary Hanman.

"We are making every effort to encourage Congress to change the Orders or to delay the referendum as has been requested by the National Milk Producers Federation (NMPF). The only thing we can say for sure right now is that we will vote and we will continue to work for improvements in the system."

According to DFA Board Chairman Herman Brubaker, voting in the 10 Federal orders in which DFA has membership has been delegated to DFA's 15-member executive committee and DFA

"In view of potential changes in Federal order reform that could come about as a result of legislative initiatives, the board decided to delegate their voting responsibility," said Brubaker.

"This vote puts dairy farmers between a rock and a hard place," Brubaker continued. "Producers are forced to choose between two 'bad' options - living with regulations we have not supported during the rulemaking process or not having any Federal milk marketing orders at all."

DFA is continuing to urge passage of HR 1402, introduced by Congressman Roy Blunt (R-MO), and passed by the House Agriculture Committee early in July. The bill preserves the USDA decision to reduce milk marketing orders from 31 to 11, and restores major provisions dropped by the Secretary of Agriculture that maintain income to dairy farmers across the country.

Dairy Farmers of America is a dairy marketing cooperative that markets milk for 25,000 dairy farmer members in 45 states. DFA supplies milk to bottling and manufacturing plants that produce a complete line of dairy products and food components for consumers in the U.S. and around the




