Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was sluggish and many sellers noted unsuccessful attempts to satisfactorily clear ample offerings. Live supplies remained at least moderate; weights were mixed in a range of light to heavy. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were 1 cent lower at 50 to 62 cents. Trade sentiment continued weak and unsettled. In the parts complex, where light and spotty sales were reported, they were usually at highly competitive levels as buyers were reluctant to book any items in excess of their limited needs and sellers were anxious to clear inventories.

The majority of trading in all categories was higher. The market tone was steady to firm. Demand was light as sellers increased prices in response to elevated shell egg price levels. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingre-

dients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending July 17, 1999 were 6% more than last week, and 7% less than the same week a year ago. Shell egg supplies were generally adequate from regular sources.
