Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 1.00 higher with good demand. Steer calves steady to 2.00 lower. Heifer calves steady. Demand for calves moderate as temperatures hover around 100 degrees. Quality plain to average, end attractive and this an improvement from last week's plain consist. Feeder cattle in

medium to moderate flesh, end fleshy. Weigh-ups average to full. Slaughter cows 1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00-2.00 higher. Packer demand good with slaughter numbers on the decline. Total of 300 cows and bulls sold with 55 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 8,700; last week 9,385; last year 10,180. Supply consisted of 74 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 23 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 3 percent cows and bulls. Heifers comprised 39 percent of supply. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
