CATTLE: Compared to Tuesday, the slaughter steer market was mixed. Trading was active for high Choice and Prime cattle with prices ranging firm to .50 higher. However, demand was only moderate for average Choice and lower grades with those types selling weak to .50 lower. Holstein steers sold steady and a light test of slaughter heifers traded steady to .50 lower. Slaughter cows sold .50-1.00 higher with the full advance placed on the fleshier cows, while a plain offering of slaughter bulls sold 2.00-3.00 lower. Supply included 46 percent slaughter steers and 31 percent slaughter cows.

Supply included 463 head in the State graded sale and around 92 percent of the calves returned to feed.

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
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
