Spillover strength from Tuesday's trading pushed grain and soybean bidshigher again today. Overnight export orders from South Korea was also asupport factor for bids. Wheat 1 to 10 cents higher. Corn 1 to 4 cents higher. Sorghum 3 cents higher. Soybeans 1 to 8 cents higher. Some rain delays in spring wheat harvest was reported in some areas but higher corn and bean bids and overnight export sales were the major supportfactors for wheat today. This has been a fairly good week for wheat exportsales. Corn and soybean bids were moderately higher due to good overnight salesto South Korea. The slight declines in crop conditionratings this week, underpinned corn and bean bids. Soybean bids also movedhigher due to stronger meal demand.
