Cumberland County Holds 4-H Roundup

(Cumberland Co.) — William Leib, Mechanicsburg, and Shane Conaway, Newville, each had several champions to sell at the Cumberland County 4-H

Livestock Roundup Sale held on Aug. 9 at the Shippensburg Fairgrounds.

Leib sold the grand champion market hog weighting 246 pounds which brought a bid of \$660 from Duron Pain Co.

Leib also sold the lightweight

reserve champion market lamb that weighed 99 pounds and received a bid of \$250 from Egberts Paints and Wallcoverings, and also sold the reserve grand champion market goat that weighed 69 pounds and received a bid of \$420 from Center Hollow Hunting Preserve.

Conaway, Newville, sold the 118-pound grand champion market lamb at the sale earning a \$520 bid from buyer Keystone Financial.

He also sold two more champions — the heavyweight champion market lamb that weighed in at 141 pounds and received a bid of \$375 from Egberts Paints and Wallcoverings, and the reserve grand champion market hog weighting 246 pounds and earning a bid of \$510 from Shetron Welding.

The reserve grand champion market lamb weighing 117 pounds sold by Jaime Fought of Carlisle was bought by Kens Agri Service for \$420.

Fought also sold the lightweight champion market lamb that received a bid of \$260 from Rockwell Farm.

Jesstin Holtry of Newville

sold the champion pair of market lambs to Art Smith and Chester Raudabaugh of Plumbing & Heating.
