HORST SALE

A Public Sale of American, Pennsylvania German and early European books and imprints, children's books and antique reference boosk was held Saturday at Horst Auctioneers in Ephrata. There were 285 registered bidders present.

Highlights of the sale included an 1884 Colgate Co. catalog of toilet soaps and perfumes \$2150, 1743 Saur Germantown Bible \$1300 and the book, "Enemies in the Rear: The Secession Movement During The Civil War" which sometimes called the "Golden Circle" book \$1025.
