

# New Agriculture Education Partnership

Guy Donaldson, president of Pennsylvania Bureau said, "We are pleased to see agriculture education getting the attention it deserves. Strong agricultural education programs are essential to today's youth - the future of Pennsylvania agriculture. The partnership that we signed here today is another positive step in ensuring that agriculture remains Pennsylvania's No. 1 industry."

Thirteen agriculture organizations signed a "Proclamation of Collaboration," officially creating the innovative partnership. The action group will work to create an efficient and effective system for providing kindergarten through adult agriculture education that will include

components of agriculture awareness and workforce development. The alliance also will serve as a networking mechanism for organizations to collaborate and cooperate for agriculture education programs.

The Ridge Administration is dedicated to improving the quality of agriculture education in Pennsylvania's schools. In the 1999-2000 budget, Gov. Ridge earmarked \$51.5 million for vocational-technical education programs such as agriculture education, an increased of \$1.6 million, or 3.3 percent.

More than 11,000 students are enrolled in agriculture education programs across Pennsylvania.

ship include: Pennsylvania Agriculture Awareness Foundation; Pennsylvania Alliance for Environmental Education; Pennsylvania Association of Agriculture Educators; Pennsylvania Association of Conservation Districts Inc.; Pennsylvania Farm Bureau; Pennsylvania Farm Link; Pennsylvania Farmers Union; Pennsylvania FFA Association; Pennsylvania FFA Foundation; Pennsylvania State Grange; Pennsylvania Young Farmers Association; Pennsylvania 4-H; and PennAg Industries.
