Flesh conditions of calves improved for buyers as many in slightly thin to moderate flesh. Yearling cattle plain in quality but condition to the thin side. Weigh-ups mostly average. Slaughter cows 2.00 lower. Slaughter buils 1.00 lower. Packer demand light, but demand very good for replacement and stocker cows. Total of 445 cows and bulls sold with 40 percent to packers. Receipts this week 9.324; last week 10.681; 11.723. Supply consisted of 53 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 42 percent calves under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. 47 percent of feeder and calf supply were heifers. 
