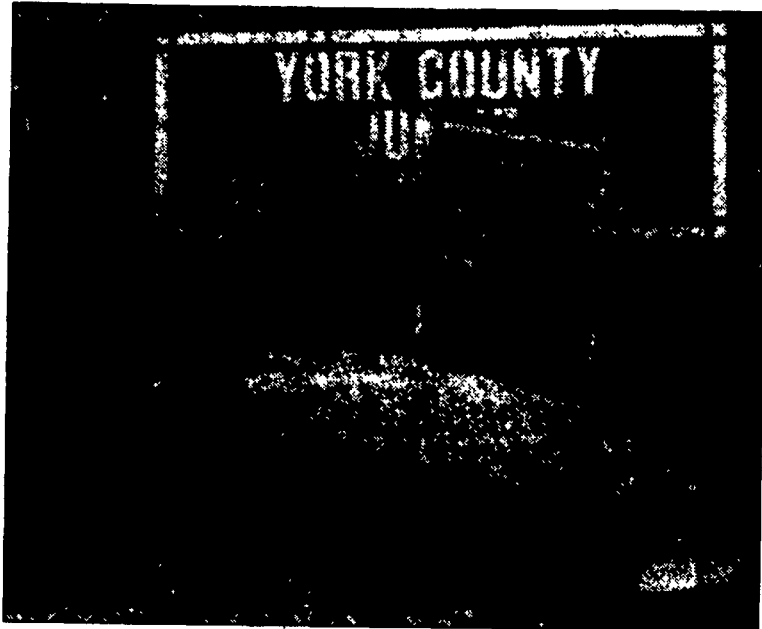
osa Farms, East Berlin. Champion heavyweight, shown by Hope Long, sold to Godfrey Bros. Meats on an 80-cent bid.

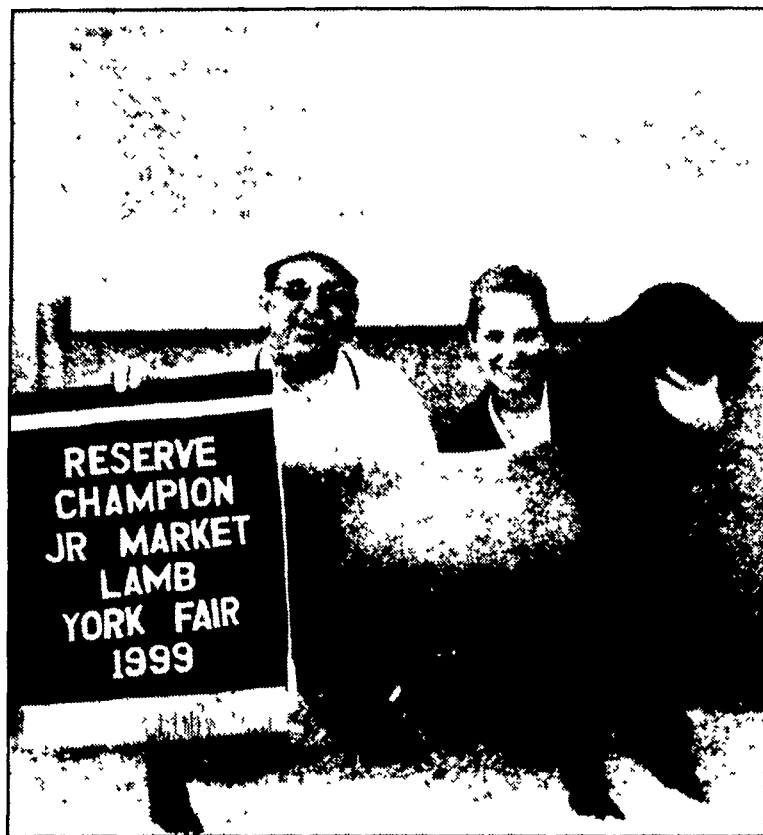

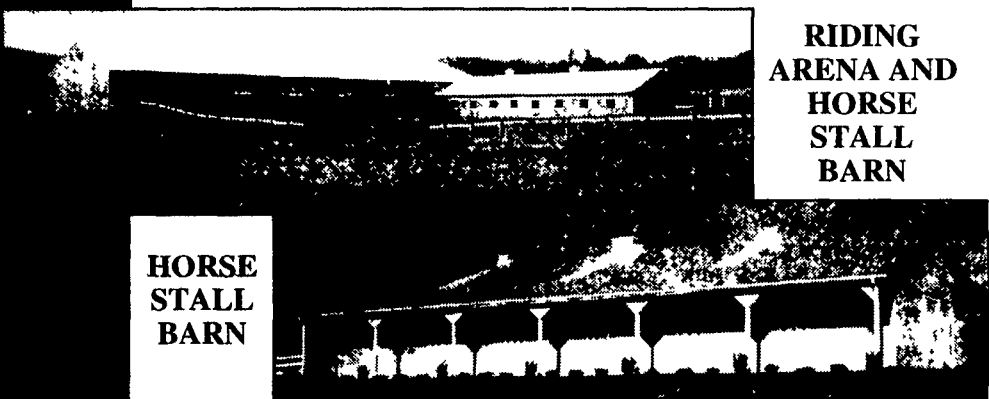
Matt Hoover's reserve champion market hog sold to Hoss's Steak and Sea House, represented by Rob Billet.

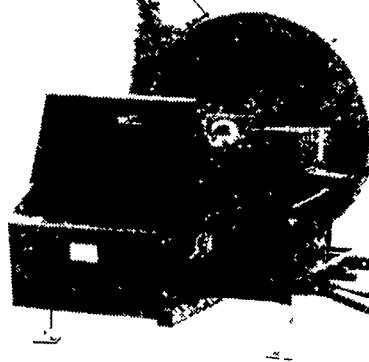
