Wheat bids were slightly lower as lack of fresh export news this week and some profit taking weighed on bids. Corn and soybean bids moved higher as traders position themselves ahead of Friday's USDA production report. Expectations for smaller production figures offered some strength to bids. Wheat mostly steady to 1 cent lower except Minneapolis 2 cents higher. Corn steady to 3 cents higher. Sorghum 2 to 5 cents higher. Soybeans 1 to 5 cents higher.
