CATTLE Compared to Thursday, slaughter steers and a light test of heifers sold 50 to mostly 100 higher. The market continues to improve and price ranges are tightening up, with most of the advancement on the bottom side. A light run of Holstein steers sold fully steady. Slaughter cows sold steady to weak and slaughter bulls were steady to 100 higher. Supply included 48 percent slaughter steers and 43 percent slaughter cows.

Trading was very active for Holstein calves returning to feed and prices were sharply higher. Holstein bulls sold 35.00-50.00 higher and heifers traded 30.00 to as much as 70.00 higher. Supply included 660 head in the State graded sale and 94 percent returned to feed.

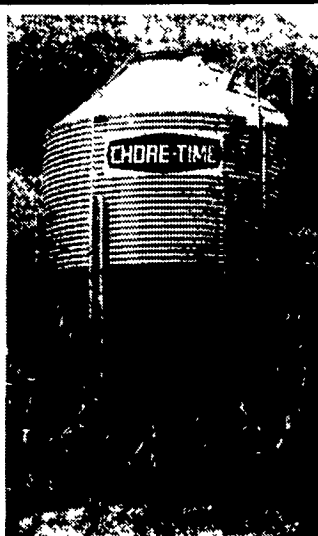

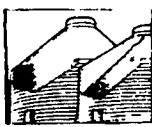

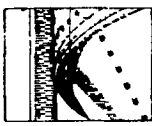
