Whole egg prices were unchanged to lower, whites were lower, and yolk products were unchanged to higher. The market tone was fully steady to firm on yolks and barely steady to weak on the balance. Demand was generally fair. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending October 2, 1999 were 7% less than last week, and unchanged from last year. Shell egg supplies were ample.

Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were light to heavy, mostly desirable to heavy. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 48 to 60 cents. Trade sentiment was cautiously steady. In the parts complex, all items were at least adequate for the seasonally light to fair and mostly selective buying interest.
